What is the Function/Mission of the TVNCOE?

- Assist in conducting inspections and examinations on towing vessels
- Interpret policy and program guidance for the towing vessel examination/inspection program
- Conduct outreach and develop informal partnerships with the towing industry and government stakeholders
- Develop, maintain, and update curriculum for Towing Vessel Examination/Inspection training
- Assist with elements of the Towing Vessel Bridging Program

What is the Purpose of the Bridging Program?

- To ease towing vessel operators into an inspection regime
- •To enhance, improve, & increase CG interactions with the towing industry
- To acclimate all stakeholders to the procedures, policy, & requirements of an inspection program
- To avoid disruptions to commerce when the regulations become effective







Guiding Principles

- ✓ Coast Guard personnel shall engage the towing vessel industry in the <u>spirit of partnership and cooperation</u> during this transition to inspection and certification.
- ✓ All encounters will be measured and <u>professional</u> while ultimately <u>ensuring compliance</u> with applicable safety, security, and environmental protection regulations.
- ✓ <u>Transparency</u> will be the hallmark of this program both internally and externally.
- ✓ Examine **every** UTV that will be inspected under Subchapter M during the Bridging Period.

Summer 2009

Phase 1

- ✓Outreach & Education

18-24 months later

- ✓ Development of Formal Training

Phase 3

- √COI Issuance
- ✓ Priority Ordering
- √ Formal Training





Phase 1

- Outreach
 - Interaction between CG and Industry at all levels
 - Learn each others cultures/get used to each other
- Education
 - Indoctrination Program for all Examiners
 - Complete Qualification Requirements
- Industry Scheduled Exams
 - At Industry's Convenience
 - Goal to get as many Tows/Tugs decaled as possible

Bridging and Implementation Team (BAIT)

- WG1: Develop Industry Orientation & Indoc Program
- WG2: Develop Training & Quals for Towing Vessel Examiners
- WG3: Propose MISLE content & upgrades for Tow Vsl Exams
 - develop a MISLE Job Aid for Towing Vessel
 Examinations
- WG4: Create Risk Based Targeting Tool to help prioritize
 CG initiated exams in Phase II.







Homeland Security What has been accomplished so far?

- Industry/CG Working Groups Have Completed
 - New Examiner Indoctrination Program
 - Examiner Qualification Standard (PQS)
 - Uninspected Towing Vessel MISLE User Guide
 - Towing Vessel Examination Guide
 - Examination Forms, Decals
- New Towing Vessel Examiners (~100) have shown up at units and are being indoctrinated and trained
- Two Districts have held formal "Roll-out" training for their new examiners with more Districts to follow
- Over 15 companies hosting over 20 CG personnel in the Indoctrination program.
- 28 Qualified examiners








